Our staff are adhering to strict health and safety guidelines in accordance with advice supplied by the HPA – Health Protection Agency.

We have made changes within our organisation to maintain the safeguarding of our employees and their families;

- face to face meetings have been replaced with telephone conferencing
- staff where possible are working from home
- visitors are no longer permitted on site
- additional protection has been put in place for high-risk employees, including those who are pregnant, aged 70 or over and employees who have long term health conditions. We are advising all high-risk employees to self-isolated
- our managers have been briefed on how to spot the symptoms of coronavirus and are clear on the steps they should take
- ensuring our manufacturing sites are clean and ensuring our employees continue best practice in this area.
- employees are following the safe distance guidelines within the work environment
- a communications team has been created to ensure that everyone is updated on the ever changing situation to ensure that mitigating actions are undertaken to reduce risks in the workplace.
